ORDER

M/s.KVM Trust, Cherthala vide letter read as first paper above, has requested to grant No Objection Certificate to start M.Pharm course in KVM College of Pharmacy, Cherthala from the academic year 2015-16. The Director of Medical Education, Thiruvananthapuram vide paper read as second above has reported that in the case of Pharmacy Practice, M/s.KVM trust may be given NOC as the institution has enough facility to conduct the course. Whereas in the case of Pharmacology there is some defects pointed out under inspection.

2. Government have examined the proposal in detail and are pleased to grant No Objection Certificate valid for two years to M/s.KVM Trust to start M.Pharm course in Pharmacy Practice from the academic year 2015-16 subject to the conditions that the institution:

- i. Shall remit Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Only) each as Application fee and as Processing fee respectively for the course under the following heads of account
0210-03-101-97-01 Application fee
0210-03-101-97-02 Processing fee
- ii. Shall obtain final approval of All India Council of Technical Education, New Delhi for starting the course from 2015-16
- iii. Shall obtain affiliation from the Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur for starting the course from 2015-16
- iv. Shall admit students on 50% merit basis from the rank list prepared by Government and 50% on Management basis on merit and agree to admit students at the rate of fee fixed by Government from time to time, subject to the other conditions for each year.
- v. Shall execute an Agreement and affidavit with Government in the Health and Family Welfare (K) Department on (iv) above before starting the courses.
- vi. Shall produce Bank Guarantee of Rs.10 lakhs valid for two years for the aforesaid course.
- vii. Shall provide all infrastructural facilities including class rooms, laboratories, equipments, hostels and teaching staff for the aforesaid course in accordance with the norms and standards of AICTE

- viii. Shall report to Government after completion of formalities (i) to (vii) above, to consider granting of Letter of Permission and the course will be started only after getting Letter of Permission from Government.
- ix. No Objection Certificate shall be valid for a period of two years.
